January 8, 2019

Angela Murphy, Chair, called to order the regular quarterly meeting of the Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) on January 8, 2019, at 2:00 p.m., at the Allen County Regional Hospital.

Attendance sheet is attached.

Dave Bass moved that the minutes from October 9, 2018, be accepted as presented. Rick Finuf seconded.

Updates:

- There are several local trainers for the Stop the Bleed course. Funding has become available and Step the Bleed Kits have been placed in local classrooms and other relevant places.
- Jason Trego, Emergency Manager, announced the County's Emergency Operation Plan (EOP) has been submitted and accepted at the State level. The Allen County Commissioners will be looking at it next for approval.
- Local agencies receiving funding from CMS completed an infectious disease tabletop and a full scale exercise.
- The TEPW (Training and Exercise Planning Workshop) calendar reflects this year's exercise to be a search and rescue scenario.
- Required Tier II reporting for emergency and hazardous chemical inventory is due to Kansas Department of Health and Environment, LEPC, and the fire department.
- A Regional exercise is scheduled for March 5, in Pittsburg. Registration is required on Kansas Train. This is a hazardous material spill exercise.
- A Mitigation planning meeting for the SE Kansas Region is scheduled for March 4 at the Allen County Courthouse. It is a planning meeting and informational meeting about available funding after a disaster.
- A list of upcoming training opportunities is attached.

New Business:

- The Governor has issued an executive order to rescind the local drought declaration,
- LEPC's By-Laws will be reviewed and reported to KDEM. Angela will send these out and any proposed revisions will be discussed at the next meeting.

- Plans for the TEPW is a search and rescue scenario. Anyone wishing to participate is welcome.
- LEPC meetings will continue to be held quarterly.
- Received feedback from members regarding possible speakers and presentations.
